1. Statewide Curfew Lifted:

As you may be aware, Governor DeWine lifted the 11pm-5am statewide curfew, effective immediately. Businesses, including bars and restaurants are now free to operate during all normal business hours. All other restrictions, including social distancing requirements, face covering requirements, cleaning requirements, etc. remain in place and must continue to be followed.
