State of Ohio Health Orders Update:

As you may be aware, Governor DeWine has announced that all of the State of Ohio Health Orders will expire as of June 2nd, with the exception of those orders governing healthcare facilities. This includes the expiration of the State's "Mask Mandate." However, private businesses are allowed to continue requiring employees and customers to wear masks if they so desire.
