## Report of Mayor & Department Heads

- South Euclid Poet Laureate Doc Janning recited the evening's poem "Magik".
- Mayor Welo reported that all directors are in attendance except Police Chief Mays who is excused.
- Planning & Development Director Love gave an update on the Leopardo Project and reported that work is substantially completed, and that City Council will tour the project and that all projects should be completed in time for the September 10<sup>th</sup> Community Open House.
- Building Commissioner Heilman reported that this morning the City's two Dollar General stores were closed by the City due to substantial violations and hazards and they will be allowed to reopen when violations have been addressed. Council President Gray gave an overview of the history of issues with the stores and how filthy they have been for over a year.
- City Engineer Blackley reported that the Oakmount project is moving along with the installation of new watermains and connections for the storm sewers. Mr. Blackley gave updates on the Mayfield Road Concrete Repair and Green Road projects and reported that the City will bid next week for the resurfacing of parking lots in City Parks and resurfacing of South Belvoir Blvd. Mr. Blackley stated that the Cuyahoga County did award a grant for the Belvoir project and Director Benjamin is working to secure additional funding.
- Fire Chief Csire reported on some concerns with traffic blocking the Fire Department driveway and potential solutions. Mr. Csire thanked Dr. Shelly Senders for donating a property so that the fire department can conduct invaluable training.
- Community Development Director Benjamin gave an update on the Victory Park project and requested City Council consideration of Resolution 46-22 to enter into an agreement with F. Buddie Contracting for construction of the new Victory Park.
- Mayor Welo thanked Community Center Director Martines for her work planning the successful band concerts at Notre Dame College.
- Mayor Welo reported that Finance Director Brenda Wendt has accepted a new job with the Cleveland Municipal School District and while we're sad to see her leave the city, it's a great career opportunity for Ms. Wendt who will be an executive with the School District. Mayor Welo reported that Ms. Wendt will continue to provide financial oversight until we find a new Finance Director and thanked her for her public service.
